



# HANGMAN GAME

**2 Players**

**Contents:** Base and Pole, 9 SpongeBob body parts.


**Object:** To guess your opponent's word, one letter at a time, before putting SpongeBob back together.

**Setup:**


- 1) Place all SpongeBob pieces on the table between both players.
- 2) Carefully, assemble the plastic base as shown in Diagram 1.
- 3) Obtain a pad or paper with pencil for each player to write down the letters.

**To Play:**


- 1) Youngest player goes first.
- 2) Player 1 chooses a word, writes it down on his paper, informs the other player how many letters are in the word and writes numbers under each letter. (Example: under the first letter, place a #1, under the second letter, place a #2, etc.) See Diagram 2. Player 2 writes that many spaces and numbers on his paper in the same manner.
- 3) Player 2 calls out one letter at a time (any letter). If that letter is contained in the word, the first player must tell the opponent the number under the letter. Player 2 then writes that letter in the correct space on his paper.
- 4) If the letter that Player 2 calls out is not contained in Player 1's word, then Player 1 hangs a single part of Sponge Bob, starting with his hat, on the blue pole. See Diagram 3.
- 5) Player 2 continues to guess letters until the word is completely spelled out or until all the pieces of SpongeBob are put together.
- 6) If the word is spelled out first, Player 2 wins. If SpongeBob's parts are completely put back together, Player 1 wins.
- 7) To play again, just start over with a new piece of paper.
- 8) Now it's Player 2's turn to pick a word.
